Ticket Ordering Timeline

Graduating Senior Pre-Sale - Mon, April 25 - Sun, May 1

- A password will be e-mailed to you individually in order to access ticket sales at this time.
- Families of graduating seniors may purchase an unlimited number of additional tickets at this time.

Volunteer & Sponsor Pre-Sale - Mon, May 2 - Sun, May 15

- A maximum of 8 tickets per dancer may be purchased by volunteers & sponsors at this time.
- A password will be e-mailed to you individually in order to access ticket sales at this time.

Family Pre-Sale - Mon, May 16 - Mon, May 30 (Memorial Day)

- Tickets on sale for all CREO Families.
- A maximum of 8 tickets per dancer may be purchased by families at this time.
- A password will be required to access ticket sales during Family Pre-Sale. This password will be shared on weekly news and emailed to you the week of <u>May 8th.</u>

General Sales - Tues, May 31 - Mon, June 6

- Families may purchase an unlimited number of additional tickets at this time.

At the Door Sales - Tues, June 7 - Sat, June 11

- Dress Rehearsal Tickets will be sold at the door for family members unable to attend the performance date.
 - Parents (particularly of young dancers,) are not required to purchase a dress-rehearsal ticket to assist their dancer through the dress rehearsal process (costume changes, etc...)

Who: Dress Rehearsal is <u>required for all dancers</u> and provides dancers a chance to get a feel for the stage before performing for a large audience.

How does Dress Rehearsal Work?

- See the final pages of this packet for your class's dress rehearsal call time.
- Dancers must be fully prepared with their costume, performance undergarments, hair, and makeup stage-ready at the start of their dress and recital call time.
- All dancers enter the theater and find the row designated for their class.
- A CREO Representative will call dancers up from the audience and dressing room to line up by the stage 5 minutes before their dress rehearsal stage time.
- Dancers who must change costumes quickly may leave their things in the dressing room backstage
- All dancers in the first call time must stay through Finale rehearsal.
- After your dancer has rehearsed all his/her dances (including Finale!!) they are dismissed unless otherwise communicated!

More Information

- Remember to pack <u>water</u> and a healthy dinner or snacks if you have a long rehearsal night.
 Please eat in the designated eating areas outside. Be sure to protect your costume while you eat by wearing a large zip-up sweatshirt or button-down shirt.
- Picture Day photos and pre-ordered recital apparel will also be available for pickup at dress rehearsal!

- Questions on dress rehearsal and recital day should be directed to staff and volunteers stationed at the "Welcome Table."
- Tickets, recital keepsake items, and concessions will be on sale at dress rehearsal
