#### **How does Dress Rehearsal Work?**

- Dancers should arrive stage-ready with their first costume, performance undergarments, hair, and makeup at the start of their dress rehearsal call time.
- Dancers enter the theater and find the row designated for their class.
- Dancers who must change costumes quickly may leave their things in the dressing room backstage.
- A CREO Staff member will call dancers to the backstage area two dances before their turn to rehearse.
- Each dance has 7 minutes to rehearse on stage.
- When dancers are not changing, rehearsing on stage, or called to wait backstage, they should remain seated in the theater to reduce traffic in the dressing room where dancers will be changing.
- Remember to pack <u>water</u> and a healthy dinner or snacks if you have a long rehearsal night.
   Please eat in the designated eating areas. Be sure to protect your costume while you eat by wearing a large zip-up sweatshirt or button-down shirt.
- All dancers in the first call time must stay through Finale rehearsal.
- After your dancer has rehearsed all his/her dances (including Finale!!) they are dismissed unless otherwise notified!

#### **How does Recital Work?**

- Dancers may arrive in warm-up attire (CREO jacket, tank top, & leggings,) with their hair & make-up done.
- Dancers will be directed to drop their things in their dressing area (either the backstage dressing room OR the cafeteria) and then report to the stage to rehearse Family Dance and Finale.
- After rehearing Family Dance and Finale, dancers are dismissed to their dressing areas to change into their first costume.
- Dancers who must change costumes quickly may set their quick-change costumes in the backstage quick-change area.
  - o For dancers stationed in the cafeteria a quick change is defined as 3 or fewer dances to change.
  - For dancers stationed in the backstage dressing room a quick change is defined as 1 dance to change.
- Doors will open 20 minutes before the show begins!
