- Being seated in a row within the audience designated for the class at <u>both</u> dress rehearsal & recital.
- Escorting the dancers to and from the stage before and after their performance.
- Assisting dancers in multiple dances with costume changes.

*Class Mom Volunteers **do not** need to purchase a ticket for themselves to attend recital as they will sit in the reserved area with the dancers.

How does Dress Rehearsal Work?

- 1) Dancers arrive at the start of their call time fully prepared in costume, hair and make-up. <u>Please</u> enter the theater and find the row designated for their class.
- 2) Dancers who have a costume change may leave their things in the backstage dressing room and should notify their class mom that they have a costume change. A "Class Mom" will accompany the dancer to assist with their costume change. A reminder that for performance, tights serve as the dancer's underwear
- 3) A CREO staff member will call classes up from the audience two dances before their turn to rehearse.
- 4) Each dance has 7 minutes to rehearse on stage
- 5) After your dancer has rehearsed all his/her dances (including Finale!!) they are dismissed unless otherwise notified!
